At the 2 day workshop, you will be practically taken through website design and other digital skills in order to be empowered to:


- implement ICT integration as recommended in the new curriculum,

The entry fee for the workshop is only **UGX 40,000** for a ticket which grants you access to the zoo, all meals (breakfast and lunch for the two days), a WordCamp T-shirt, internet access, training materials and other logistics!

Accommodation in dormitories at UWEC is provided at **UGX 30,000** per night but you are required to carry bedsheets and personal effects. For those who prefer private accommodation outside the Zoo, there are self-contained guest houses at an average fee of UGX 50,000. Transport from Kampala Taxi Park to Entebbe Zoo is only UGX 5,000.
